Proposal: Proposed Garden Room

Location: Chime House, Audlem Road, Hankelow,

Date for receipt of comments: 11 October 2023

It was RESOLVED that Cheshire East Council be advised as follows:

- The Parish Council would not support this application at this height, at the
  position indicated on the diagram, specifically it is noted that it is 3.6 metres
  high and looking at the plans it is much less than 2 metres from the
  boundary. Additionally, the ground falls away between this house and the
  neighbouring property.
- The Parish Council noted that the diagram is incorrect in that the orientation of the building is to the south south-west of the neighbouring properties.

- Under the original planning approval given for this property, the landscaping
  has not been fulfilled and had it been fulfilled the development would result
  in the removal of trees.
- The Parish Council would ask Cheshire East consider this application on its own merit, in particular take account of the fact that CEC was opposed to the demolition of Grey House
